Arriving at Premier Automation

Directions from Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport:

- Head east on N Terminal Pkwy to I-85 N.
- 5.5 miles I-85 N merges with I-75 N.
- 7.5 miles Stay in left 3 lanes for I-85 N.
- 2.75 Miles Right 2 lanes - Exit 87 GA400 N.
- 24 miles Exit 12B McFarland Pkwy.
- 2.5 miles Turn right on Hwy 9 N.
- 0.5 mile Turn right on Grassland Pkwy.
- 0.6 mile Turn right on to Engineering Pkwy.
- Premier Automation is on the right.

Drive distance and Time: 44 mile approx., 45 minutes

Did You Know These Atlanta Facts?

- Atlanta was originally named Terminus and Marthasville (the latter for Governor Wilson Lumpkin's daughter.)
- The city got its current name from railroad engineer J. Edgar Thompson. It's thought to be a shortened version of "Atlantica-Pacific."
- Your GPS might be confused if you punch in "Peachtree" as your destination. There are over 55 streets with the name.
- Atlanta is Georgia's fifth capital. Savannah, Augusta, Louisville, and Milledgeville boasted the title earlier.
- The Georgia State Capitol building is gilded with 43 ounces of locally-mined gold.
- When pro football moved to Atlanta, the owners considered over 500 names. A schoolteacher came up with the Falcons nickname, a bird she endorsed because it was "proud and dignified, with great courage and fight."
- After being mostly burned to the ground during the American Civil War, the city rose from its ashes to become a national center of commerce and the unofficial capital of the "New South."
- Lots of airports claim to be the world's busiest, but Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport truly is the world's busiest airport.
- The airport terminal is as big as 45 football fields.
- The Atlanta-metro is the 17th largest economy on the planet.
- Atlanta is home to the Eastern Continental Divide, which separates the two watersheds of the Atlantic Ocean: the Gulf of Mexico and the Atlantic Seaboard.
- The Varsity, one of Atlanta's most beloved landmarks, is the world's largest drive-in restaurant. It can accommodate 600 cars outside and 800 people inside.
- Atlanta has more shopping center space per capita than any other city in the country besides Chicago.
